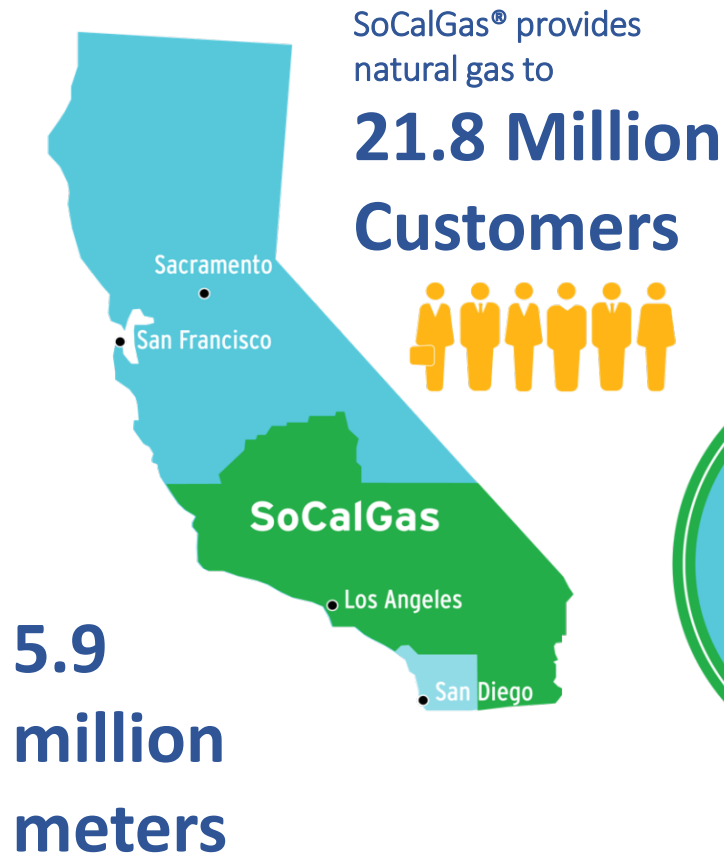

# California Senate Bill -1371

- Senate Bill (SB)-1371 (2014) requires utilities to reduce emissions of natural gas to the maximum extent feasible, while giving priority to safety, reliability, and affordability.
- In 2015, the CPUC implemented SB-1371 through Decision 17-06-015 which requires large Utilities to:
  - Submit biennial compliance plans and annual emissions reports
  - Implement 26 best practices to reduce methane emissions
  - Achieve a reduction of at least 20% from 2015 levels by 2025
- SoCalGas has achieved an overall reduction in system emissions from the 2015 Baseline of 37% as of the 2022 Annual Report for 2021 system emissions.
